### JANE'S personal *Possessions*

A stone's throw from Jane's final resting place in Winchester Cathedral, City Museum is home to three of Jane's personal possessions, two purses embroidered by her own hand and a personalised ivory spool case. The author's silk pelisse coat is one of a handful of items that survive today that belonged to Jane and can be traced directly back to her.



Rarely on public display, Jane's coat will be on show at City Museum from 22 May – 16 June and 27 July – 20 October 2025. Group adult: £5.50 (standard £8.00)
